Dayton's Oregon District Memorial

In the very early morning hours of Sunday, August 4th, 2019, multiple gunshots rang out in Dayton's Historic Oregon District. The unimaginable had happened close to home. In the course of just 32 seconds, a shooter opened fire in this entertainment district in downtown taking 9 lives before being shot dead himself by 6 heroic Dayton police officers. Many others were injured in the shooting, some very seriously.

On Friday, August 23rd, Ferncliff Funeral Home & Crematory Executive Director, Rob Jones, was appointed to an 11-person committee charged with fundraising for and designing of a permanent memorial to those affected by the tragedy. Dayton's Mayor, Nan Whaley, heads the committee.
